BAPTISMS: Presenting a child for Baptism is a serious obligation and requires a faith commitment on the part of the parents and godparents. This commitment is exemplified by being a practicing, active Catholic. Parents are obligated to attend a preparation session before a child's baptism if they have not attended one in the past five years. Sessions are held at 1:15 p.m. on second Sundays of January, March, May, July, September and November, in the Parish Activity Center. Baptisms are at 1:15 p.m. on the third Sunday of January, February, March, April, May, June, August, September, October, November and December and on the second Sunday of July.

WEDDINGS: Please phone the parish office to set-up an appointment with a priest, in order to begin the sacramental preparation. Only after this initial meeting and assessment can a date be set for the wedding. The process requires at least 6 months.

Dear I.C. Parishioner,

Your Stewardship dollars at work

Thanks to your generosity our facilities are in the best shape they have been in years. All of our buildings have been tucked pointed in the last five years and sealed. They are now on a regular rotation for maintenance which will be budgeted accordingly. All the roofs have been replaced in recent years and are checked regularly. Our HVAC systems have been upgraded with more energy efficient equipment and we continue to make regular repairs. We are grateful to the Maintenance Committee, our maintenance staff and volunteers for helping us maintain the resources we have in our facilities and grounds for years to come.

Several projects are scheduled for this summer. The sidewalks along Anthony St. and both sides of Walnut St. have been deteriorating for years and becoming a safety concern. We were hoping the City of Celina would be working on those streets in the near future, but that does not seem to be the case. I.C. Church has awarded PAB construction from Coldwater a bid of \$79,950 to replace the sidewalks, curbs and gutters along Anthony St. and both sides of Walnut. They will also replace deteriorating sidewalks around the front and South side of church. They have begun sawing concrete to be removed for proper disposal along the lake and will return early June to complete the project prior to the I.C. Festival. The church and PAC parking lots will be resealed and restriped at a cost of \$9,500. The church boiler will be re-piped to make it more energy efficient at a cost of \$7,500 and the two deteriorating flat roofs on the South entrances of school will be replaced at an estimated cost of \$13,000. The other school project is the removal of asbestos in the boiler room of the new school at an estimated cost of \$45,000. Each of these projects are included in the 2016-17 budget.

A portion of the funds returned to I.C. from the Archdiocesan capital campaign will be used to repair the church dome that has been leaking, updating lighting with more energy efficient bulbs and ballasts and other energy efficient measures. The dome repair will begin in June by Wellman Brothers and is estimated at \$24,000 to \$38,000. The Maintenance Committee is developing a purchase plan and schedule for energy upgrades in the school and PAC and plans to insulate the crawl space under the church. The Maintenance Committee has a plan to continue addressing other necessary repairs and maintenance in coming years. It is our hopes to account for these repairs through our annual budget. Your continued generosity makes this possible. Thanks to the Maintenance Committee for all the hours and expertise they share to keep our Church an icon of faith and house of prayer for generations to come. And thanks to all who share your time, talent and treasure.

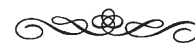
