BAPTISMS: Presenting a child for Baptism is a serious obligation and requires a faith commitment on the part of the parents and godparents. This commitment is exemplified by being a practicing, active Catholic. Parents are obligated to attend a preparation session before a child's baptism if they have not attended one in the past five years. Sessions are held at 1:15 p.m. on second Sundays of January, March, May, July, September and November, in the Parish Activity Center. Baptisms are at 1:15 p.m. on the third Sunday of January, February, March, May, June, July, August, September, October, November and December and on the fourth Sunday of April.

WEDDINGS: Please phone the parish office to set-up an appointment with a priest, in order to begin the sacramental preparation. Only after this initial meeting and assessment can a date be set for the wedding. The process requires at least 6 months.

Feast of St. Gaspar del Bufalo

The Missionaries of the Precious Blood celebrated the feast of their founder, St. Gaspar del Bufalo, on Saturday, October 21. We unite our prayers with them by celebrating this feast in our parish on the weekend of October 21-22, 2017. The readings and prayers this weekend will not be found in the missalette.

St. Gaspar del Bufalo was born on January 6, 1876 in Rome. He was ordained a priest for the diocese of Rome in 1808, and less than two years later was arrested and imprisoned for refusing to take the oath of allegiance to Napoleon. There, both his faith and determination to spread the good news of our salvation through the Precious Blood grew stronger. After three years in prison, he was released, and on August 15, 1815, he founded the Missionaries of the Precious Blood at the Abbey of San Felice in Giano, Italy. For twenty-two years, he preached missions and retreats, renewing the Church by preaching the Word and proclaiming the saving power of the Precious Blood. He died on December 28, 1837.

Order Scrip Online!

Would you prefer to order Scrip online? Here are a couple of instructions to get you started:

Get on the website, shopwithscrip.com, create an account, enter I.C.'s Enrollment Code 929EDD2421654, and click ***JOIN***. You are now enrolled and can shop, shop, shop!

Payments for your order must be made **BEFORE** we place your order, so just bring a copy of your online order to I.C. School with your cash or check by 9:00 a.m. Monday morning, and you will be able to pick your cards up by that Thursday! If school times don't work for you, you may drop your order and money off at the parish office.

Ordering is even easier if you are an online shopper and set up your payment with PrestoPay. It is just like using PayPal—you get the amount deducted automatically from your checking account. It usually takes a few days to initially set up with your bank, but it saves you a trip to school to hand in the payment.

The easiest thing of all is to order ScripNow! online and pay with PrestoPay! You can print off your certificate within **minutes**, AND no trips to school to pay!

Check out the newest Scrip app called My Scrip Wallet. You can pay for your gift certificates on your phone with Presto Pay right at the participating store. No paper or physical cards required! The cashier will just scan your phone.
