BAPTISMS: Presenting a child for Baptism is a serious obligation and requires a faith commitment on the part of the parents and godparents. This commitment is exemplified by being a practicing, active Catholic. Parents are obligated to attend a preparation session before a child's baptism if they have not attended one in the past five years. Sessions are held at 1:15 p.m. on second Sundays of January, March, May, July, September and November, in the Parish Activity Center. Baptisms are at 1:15 p.m. on the third Sunday of each month except in April when Baptism will be held on the second Sunday.

WEDDINGS: Please phone the parish office to set-up an appointment with a priest, in order to begin the sacramental preparation. Only after this initial meeting and assessment can a date be set for the wedding. The process requires at least 6 months.

Tornado Relief Update

We continue to offer our prayers, concern and support for all those affected by the Memorial Day tornado that passed through the West side of Celina and towards SR 197. Nearly 100 homes and one business including over 40 of our I.C. families experienced significant damage and numerous homes were a total loss. We continue to offer assistance and to be a support to those who are in the process of rebuilding.

In a previous bulletin insert, we noted that \$2,000 of the funds collected at I.C. were being directed to St. Vincent de Paul to help with those who may come to the Parish Office looking for assistance. Of the remaining funds collected 60% is being given to Our Home Family Resource (117 W Fayette St., Celina) to provide direct assistance for anyone in need in our Celina community. 40% is being given to Catholic Social Services to help our brothers and sisters in Dayton. While many have experienced devastating losses here in Celina, we also know that the devastation and losses in Dayton are more extensive with 200+ injuries and over 800 homes, business and other structures heavily damaged, including three Catholic Churches. It is important to care for our own, but we also know that it is important to care for those in other places who are also hurting.

We have been profoundly touched by the generosity of so many from our local Celina community and beyond. To date I.C. has received \$35,085.66 from the I.C. Church tornado relief collection and other donations from our parishioners, local communities, churches and organizations and donations from other states. You may recall that Our Home was designated by I.C. and the Archdiocese as an agency that is also receiving and distributing funds. To date, Our Home has received \$18,150.42 from I.C. for distribution. They have also received about \$12,234.40 in direct donations from local parishes and other sources. Our Home has a board reviewing applications and dispersing funds. Our St. Vincent de Paul has received \$2,000 from I.C. They have also received \$4,570 in direct donations from other St. Vincent de Paul groups and other donors. They have distributed \$1,500 so far. To date, Catholic Social Services has received approximately \$13,234.26 from I.C. to help our brothers and sisters in Dayton. I.C. provided \$1,700.98 in direct assistance to parishioners in the first few days after the tornados. It may be 3 to 6 months or more until some families know the full extent of what is covered

by insurance and what they may need additional help with. If Our Home and St. Vincent de Paul have any funds left after addressing local needs, those will be directed to other storm victims in the Dayton area.

The best of our Celina community has been coming to the forefront in the wake of this tragedy and that includes many of our IC parishioners. We thank you for all your concern, generosity and outreach and ask that we continue to offer our prayers and support for those affected by the tornado locally, those further away and all suffering from natural disasters.
